We will also seek to demonstrate compliance with legislative and regulatory requirements through the application of an effective management system.

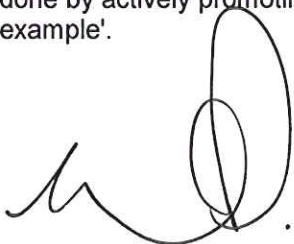
These statements are wholly consistent with the organisations' business objectives of continually seeking improvements in quality, delivery, inventory, purchase and lean savings, supported by sales.
